## **Program Overview:**

The Health Science and Technology program is a secondary technical level program that prepares students for the pursuit of a Health Science Career Pathway. The program is based on:

- Employment needs of the health care community
- National health care skill standards
- · Health care leadership and technical skills
- Post-secondary education requirements

Students may enter the program as a sophomore, junior or senior. It is suggested that Introduction to Health Science be taken prior to starting a specialty program. This will help students to better define an area of focus in the health science industry. Knowledge-building courses (Medical Anatomy & Physiology and Medical Terminology) will prepare students for vocabulary and critical knowledge needed in specialization courses.
