

Safari Montage – Instructions for Guest Teachers

I. Accessing Safari Montage and Logging In

1. Log in to the teacher computer using your district username and password.
2. Open a web browser, such as Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, or Internet Explorer.
3. Access Granite's SAFARI Montage directly by going to the following URL:

<http://safari.graniteschools.org>

(Note: If the teacher left you the URL to a specific video, click on it if possible or type it into the browser's address field and use the login info given below, and you will be taken directly to that video.)

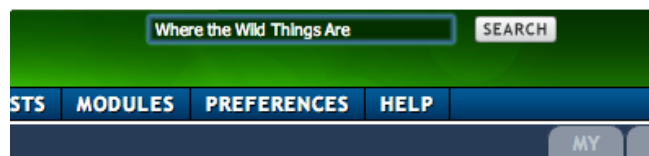


4. At the Safari Montage login screen, enter the following login information for our school:

Password: guest login info for your school to insert here]

II. Finding Videos

1. Type the title of the video the teacher would like you to show into the search box at the top of the screen, and click the **Search** button.



2. Search results are listed 10 per page by default. Click through the tabs at the top to find other items that are not videos.
3. Click on the title of the video for more details or to access individual chapters.

III. Playing Videos

1. To play a video, click the green Play button next to the title.



2. The video will begin to play in the media player. See the diagram below for some basic functions of the player.



3. When in full screen view, the controls will be hidden after a moment. Move the mouse to make the controls reappear at the bottom of the screen.
4. You can also hit the **Esc** button on the keyboard to turn off full screen viewing.
