- Back-to-school night** is not included in the contract of any secretaries and classified employees who do not have a normal evening work assignment. If these employees are required to work on this evening they must be compensated through trade time or compensatory time.
- 9 Month Secretaries and Police Officers** are assigned to work both nights of Parent-Teacher Conferences and will get the Compensatory Days off. If they do not work both nights, then Secondary Principals will require them to make up these days at a time to be determined by the Principal or Chief of Police.
- Secretaries** will begin on the dates identified. However, one work day may be traded for the Professional Development Day for those secretaries who attend the Professional Development Day outside of their contract. School based secretaries may trade the nights of Parent Teacher Conferences for the Teacher Compensatory Day.
- Fall Recess** is Thursday and Friday, October 13 and 14, 2022. These are non-working days for all contract employees.
- Winter Recess** is Friday, December 23, 2022 through Tuesday, January 3, 2023 for 12 month employees. Work resumes Wednesday, January 4, 2023.
- 12 month custodians** will trade sixteen (16) contract working hours to be used during winter recess. Not working 16 hours during winter recess must be approved under the vacation policy.
- Spring Recess** is Monday, March 27, 2023 thru Friday, March 31, 2023. These dates are working days for all 12 month employees.
- A Legislative Instructional Exemption** day is scheduled for Wednesday, November 23, 2021. **This is a contract day for all 12 month employees.**
- Emergency Closure Make-Up Day** is Friday, March 31, 2023. This will be a work day if school is closed for a day during the year due to weather or other circumstances. **This is a work day for all 12 month employees regardless of the need for a make up day.**
- Preschool Designated Trade Days** for 2022-2023 are October XX, November XX, December XX, January XX, February XX, March XX, April XX and May XX.
- High School and Junior High School Kitchens** will work August 8 & 17. **Elementary School Kitchens** will work August 8 & 15.
- Hartvigsen Instructional Assistants** will work August 8, 9, & 10. **School based Instructional Assistants** will work August 15, 16, & 17.
- Kindergarten Teachers** work August X, X, & X for kindergarten testing and do not work August XX, XX, and XX in exchange.
