



# Everything you need to know about the 3 Tier Network with SelectHealth & Regence

Current

## IN-NETWORK

SelectMed | SelectMed+ ValueCare | ValueCare+

Providers in-network agree to the insurance contracted rates, and you will pay the least amount out of pocket

## OUT-OF-NETWORK

Non-contracted Providers

Providers do not have to accept the insurance company's payment so you may be balanced billed. Your out-of-pocket costs will be higher.

## TIER 1

In-Network High Value

SelectValue | FocalPoint

**No Change** to Deductible, Out-of-pocket maximum, and coinsurance. **Cheaper office visit copays.**

## TIER 2

In-Network

SelectMed | ValueCare

**No change** to Deductible, Out-of-pocket maximum, copays and coinsurance as current plan.

## TIER 3

Out-of-Network

Non-contracted Providers

**No change** to OON Deductible, Out-of-pocket maximum and coinsurance on current SelectMed+ & ValueCare+ plans.

**Enhanced benefit for those on the ValueCare and SelectMed plans.**

## FAQs

### **Why are we making this change?**

To save money! Granite's insurance plan is self-funded which means we contract with insurance carriers to administer our plan, but the District is ultimately responsible for paying the claims. Since 2019 our claims cost has increased 12%, yet we have had several years of 0% increases to premium.

### **How does this save money?**

Providers and facilities that are part of the Tier 1 network have agreed to a lower reimbursement amount through their contracts with Select Health and Regence. More good news is that 93% of Granite School District Select Health members are already using SelectValue providers and facilities. And 92% of Regence members are already using FocalPoint providers with 40% of those members using FocalPoint providers exclusively. Now we just get to take advantage of the better contracted reimbursements.

### **Why haven't we made this change sooner?**

This tiered network product is brand new and only became available in January of 2022.

### **Do I have to make a plan selection?**

No, you simply go to any provider on the SelectValue or SelectMed network if you are enrolled on SelectHealth, or any FocalPoint or ValueCare provider if you are enrolled on Regence. You will save a little on your office visit copay if your provider is on the SelectValue or FocalPoint network (Tier 1).

### **Am I losing any benefits?**

No, you are not losing any benefits.

### **Does this change my benefits?**

This does not change your deductible, coinsurance or maximum out-of-pocket. You have the potential to save \$10 on your office visit coinsurance if you go to a provider that is on the Tier 1 network.

### **Does this impact my prescription coverage?**

Because our pharmacy program is administered by Express Scripts this change will not impact your prescription coverage.
