1. <u>Back-to-school night</u> is not included in the contract of any secretaries and classified employees who do not have a normal evening work assignment. If these employees are required to work on this evening they must be compensated through trade time or compensatory time.

2. <u>9 Month Secretaries and Police Officers</u> are assigned to work both nights of Parent-Teacher Conferences and will get the Compensatory Days off. If they do not work both nights, then Secondary Principals will require them to make up these days at a time to be determined by the Principal or Chief of Police.

3. <u>Secretaries</u> will begin on the dates identified. However, one work day may be traded for the Professional Development Day for those secretaries who attend the Professional Development Day outside of their contract. School based secretaries may trade the nights of Parent Teacher Conferences for the Teacher Compensatory Day.

4. Fall Recess is Thursday and Friday, October 12 and 13, 2023. These are non-working days for all contract employees.

5. Winter Recess is Monday, December 25, 2023 through Tuesday, January 2, 2024 for 12 month employees. Work resumes Wednesday, January 3, 2024.

6. 12 month custodians will trade sixteen (16) contract working hours to be used during winter recess. Not working 16 hours during winter recess must be approved under the vacation policy.

7. Spring Recess is Monday, April 1, 2024 thru Friday, April 5, 2024. These dates are working days for all 12 month employees.

8. <u>A Legislative Instructional Exemption</u> day is scheduled for Wednesday, November 22, 2023. This is a contract day for all 12 month employees.

9. Emergency Closure Make-Up Day is Tuesday, May 28, 2024. This will be a work day if school is closed for a day during the year due to weather or other circumstances. This is a work day for all 12 month employees regardless of the need for a make up day.

10. Preschool Designated Trade Days for 2023-2024 are September 22, October 11, November 21, December 22, January 12, February 9, March 29, and April 12.

11. High School and Junior High School Kitchens will work August 8 & 17. Elementary School Kitchens will work August 8 & 15.

12. Hartvigsen Instructional Assistants will work August 2, 3, & 4. School based Instructional Assistants will work August 9, 10, & 11.

13. Kindergarten Teachers work August 3, 4, & 5 for kindergarten testing and do not work August 18, 19, and 22 in exchange.
