**ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM NUMBER NINETY-ONE**  
**ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT**

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) became effective on December 14, 1987, requiring the district to inspect all buildings for friable and non-friable asbestos-containing materials and to develop management plans which outline action to be taken to control the release of asbestos fibers.

All schools in Granite School District have been inspected by district-accredited asbestos inspectors. A surveillance inspection of each school and relocatable building is completed each six months.

As a result of these inspections, the asbestos department maintains an asbestos management book on every school. The book is placed in each school. It identifies all asbestos-containing materials in the school building and district plans for dealing with it in the future.

The asbestos book and management plan is available for public viewing at each school. A copy of the management plan for each school is available at the District Asbestos Management Office, 280 West Gregson Avenue (3050 South) for a cost of \$3.00 each.

Asbestos removal projects have been scheduled in several buildings. These removal projects will generally be carried out in the summer months. If you wish to know if your school has removal projects scheduled, refer to the school's asbestos management plan located in each school in the office area.

PTA, GEA, and GCEA will be notified annually of the asbestos progress in the school. A copy of this notification will also be sent to each school for posting.

Training and re-training programs are in place to ensure a good program and provide safe conditions for all school building occupants.
