ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM NUMBER ONE-HUNDRED TEN
SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES

Section 76-10-106 of the 1989 Utah Code prohibits smoking in public places, public meetings, in public or private school buildings and the property in which these school buildings are located, and in places of employment where smoke pollution could be detrimental to the health or comfort of non-smoking employees.

Employees should be reminded that they may not smoke in the schools of our district nor on the property on which the schools are located. Any offices or other work places where smoke pollution could be detrimental to the health or comfort of non-smoking employees is also prohibited.

Visitors to your school may not be aware of the Utah law or of this administrative memorandum, but must also comply under this law and directive. District workers, contracted workers, parents, etc., are to be in compliance in school buildings and on school grounds because of the proximity to and frequenting of these areas by students. This is also a legal rights issue. Recent studies have again confirmed the serious health risk to others of second-hand tobacco smoke.

Please bring this matter to the attention of those involved as the need arises. Periodic reminders to employees are also important.
