ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM NUMBER ONE HUNDRED FOURTEEN
USE OF DISTRICT FACILITIES AS COMMUNITY EMERGENCY SHELTERS

Granite School District agrees that, after meeting its responsibilities to pupils and providing security to its staff and facilities, it will permit, to the extent of its ability and upon request by the Red Cross, the use of its physical facilities by the Red Cross as mass shelters for the victims of disasters. The Red Cross will contact and receive permission for the use of Granite facilities through the Granite Police Department (481-7122). The individual schools(s), School Services, and the Office of Administrative Services will be contacted by the Granite Police Department.

Appropriate school personnel, including both the building administrator and the custodian, will need to be on site during the time that the Red Cross is using district facilities. Any exceptions or other arrangements for personnel will be made through the appropriate School Services Director.

If school is to be held the next day, the Red Cross will need to have alternative plans for another location or will need to have made advanced arrangements through the District School Services office to work cooperatively with the school so that school may be held.

The American Red Cross agrees that it shall exercise reasonable care in the conduct of its activities in such facilities and further agrees to replace or reimburse Granite School District for any food or supplies that may be used by the Red Cross in the conduct of its relief activities in schools used as emergency shelters.

The Salt Lake Area Chapter of the American National Red Cross agrees to defend, hold harmless and indemnify the Granite School District against any legal liability in respect to bodily injury, death, and property damage arising from the negligence of the said chapter during its use of the property belonging to Granite School District.
