

Article III.E. Relations to Administrative Staff

Recognizing that administrative teamwork is vital to an efficient operation of the school district, the superintendent shall:

- A. Endeavor to work cooperatively with employees, employee groups, students, student groups, patrons, and patron groups.
- B. Be responsible for developing an administrative structure designed to bring efficiency in school district operations.
- C. Research or cause to be researched new ideas, stimulate thought and action on the part of staff, and offer encouragement as needed.
- D. Promote harmony; make judgments for the good of the individual and the group; and consider objectively reports and information through meeting with individuals, committees, and groups of citizens of the district.
- E. Delegate administrative authority to others to carry out the various functions of the educational programs.
