ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM NUMBER ONE-HUNDRED SEVEN
ILLEGAL USE OF STEROIDS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Because of nationwide concern over increased use of steroids by student athletes in the public schools, every effort should be made to discourage them from using steroids.

It is the position of Granite School District that principals, coaches, and teachers are responsible to see that illegal use of steroids does not occur with students under their charge.

The Utah Professional Practices Advisory Commission has issued the following statement:

"Local boards of education, principals, and coaches are reminded that encouraging, condoning or ignoring the use of steroids by student athletes under their jurisdiction is viewed by the State Board of Education as a breach of professional ethics. Any breach of ethics shall be grounds for action and may result in a hearing before the Utah Professional Practices Advisory Commission to determine the future status of the certification of any educator found to be involved in such practice."

Granite School District concurs with this statement. Further, the district will take disciplinary action against any district employee who violates this policy.
