As a consent agenda item at the November 18, 2014, Board of Education meeting, I request that the Board approve adjustments to the 2014-2015 School LAND Trust Plan for several schools. Changes requested by the schools are summarized below:

- Cottonwood Sr High
  - Allows for the purchase of a classroom set of calculators
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/7/14
- Kearns Sr. High
  - Allows funding for more para educators
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/14/2014
- Granite Connections High
  - Allows funding for additional para educators to support the individualized learning lab.
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/9/2014
- Driggs Elementary
  - Allow for a .50 kindergarten teacher
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 9/12/14
- Monroe Elementary
  - Allows for DIBELS goal to decrease from 20% BOY to EOY to 10%
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/7/2014
- Orchard Elementary
  - Allows for substitutes for professional learning.
  - Allows for the purchase of technology for classrooms
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/14/2014
- Roosevelt Elementary
  - Allows for a 10% growth in reading proficiency instead of 30%
  - Hire an additional all-day kindergarten teacher and a para educator
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/23/14

- West Valley Elementary
  - Reduce the number of paraprofessionals in order to hire a .50 teacher
  - Allows for substitutes for professional learning
  - Allows for the purchase of technology
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/9/2014
