As a consent agenda item at the February 3, 2015, Board of Education meeting, I request that the Board approve adjustments to the 2014-2015 School LAND Trust Plan for Bennion El, Oakwood El, Woodstock El, Jefferson Jr, Olympus Jr, and Hunter Sr. Changes requested by the schools are summarized below:

- Bennion Elementary
 - Allows funding for a school-wide writing program
 - Allows funding for a classroom set of Chrome books
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 11/19/2014.
- Oakwood Elementary
 - Allows funding for 3 iPads
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 11/14/2014.
- Woodstock Elementary
 - Allows for additional paraeducators
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 11/17/2014.
- Jefferson Jr High
 - Allows for conference registration for math, English, and/or science teachers.
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 11/18/2014.
- Olympus Jr High
 - Allows funding for a paraeducator
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 11/26/2014.
- Hunter Sr High
 - Clarifies the graduation rate increase to 2% due to a typing error
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 3/17/14.
