**Re:** Revised Recommended Price increases for Student and Adult meals for 2015-16 School year.

Thank you for taking my last recommendation for a meal price increase forward. I understand the rationale for not increasing prices, due to the current fund balance, as well as, not being required under the guideline of the Paid Lunch Equity regulations. As long as we can continue to promote the special functions and staff dining in the GEC Café, we can continue to have less impact on student meal prices.

Under the regulations we still need to increase the adult /second meal lunch price. The adult lunch price must be equal to or greater than the sum of the Federal reimbursement plus the commodity allocation.

$$\$3.11 + \$.2475 = 3.3575$$

**Therefore I recommend that the District increase the lunch price for adults and second meals to students to \$3.35 starting July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015.**

With the ninth graders moving up to some of the high schools we have a pricing inequity, a ninth grader attending a high school pays \$1.65 while a tenth grade student in line next to them pays \$1.75. The menu and portion size are the same. I would recommend that both lunches be set at \$1.75. Breakfast for both is currently at \$1.05.

**I recommend that all secondary students attending a high school (Grades 9-12<sup>th</sup>) pay the same lunch price of \$1.75**
