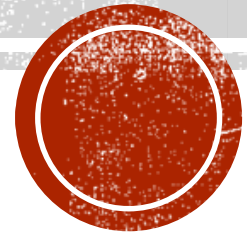

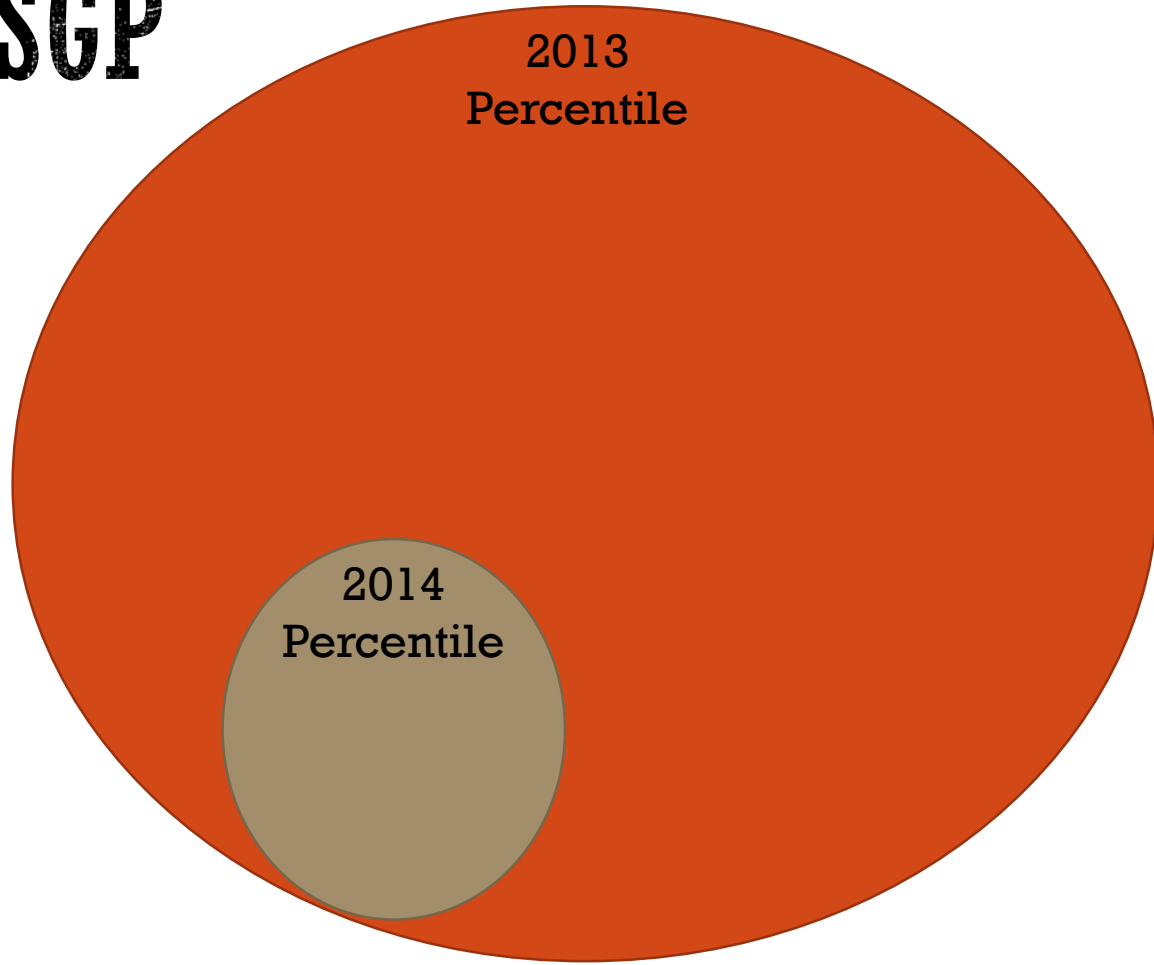

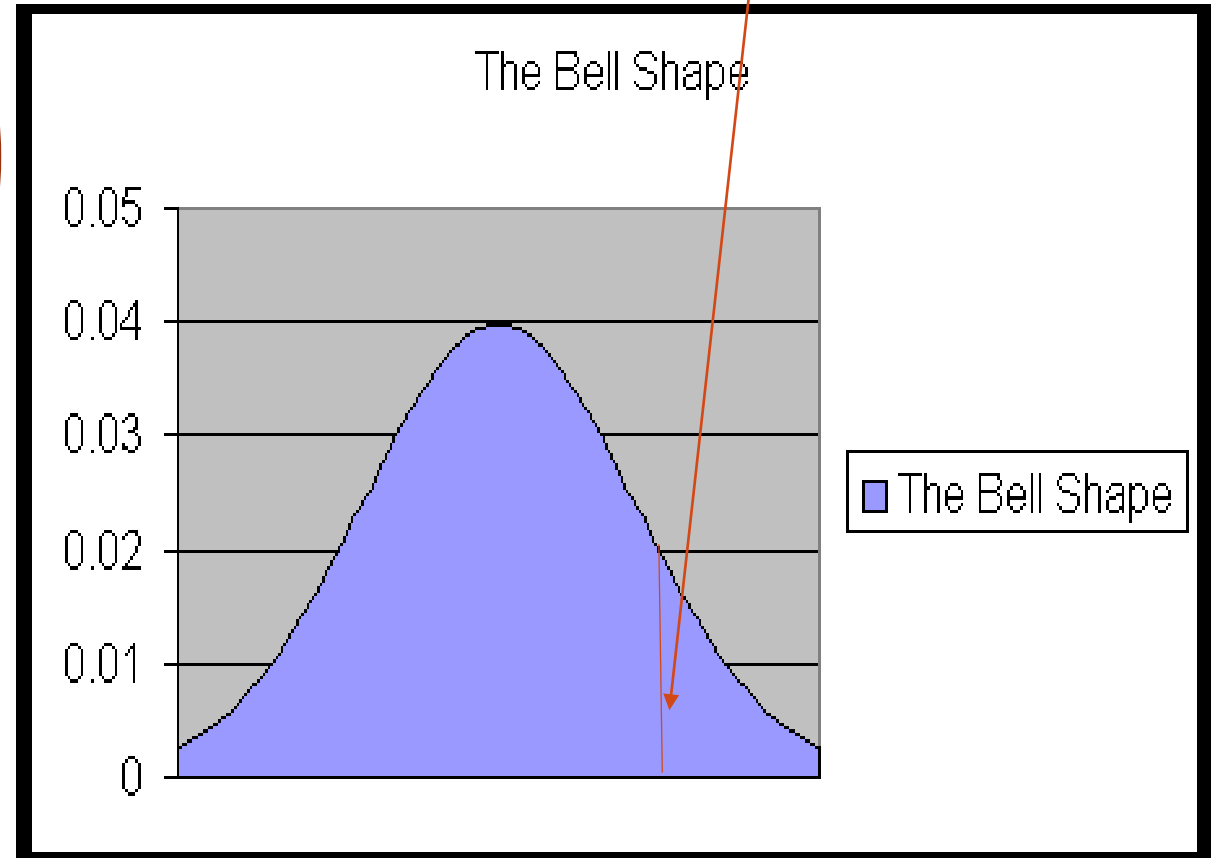

MGP

- Median Growth Percentile (MGP) is determined by finding the middle of all the SGPs in a group



SCHOOL FEDERAL ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT

- Proficiency Points (300)
 - Awarded directly as a proficiency percentage
- Growth Points for all students (200)
 - Calculated in bands
 - An MGP of 70 or higher equals
 - 200 points
 - An MGP of 30-69
 - Points are awarded by multiplying MGP by 3.75 and then minus 62.50
 - An MGP below 30
 - 50 Points
- Growth Points for below proficient students (100)
 - Calculated in bands
 - An MGP of 70 or higher equals
 - 100 points
 - An MGP of 30-69
 - Points are awarded by multiplying MGP by 1.875 and then minus 31.25
 - An MGP below 30
 - 25 Points



TITLE I RANKINGS

- Average the following for two years
 - ELA Proficiency %
 - ELA Growth %
 - Math Proficiency %
 - Math Growth %
- Then calculate the combined average for 2014 & 2015
- Rank order that percentage
- Bottom 15% = Focus (32 Schools)
- Bottom 5% = Priority (16 Schools)

TURNAROUND MODEL FOR SIG

- Replace the existing principal
- Reconstitute the staff
- Create recruitment and retention strategies



RATIONALE FOR ONLY 2 SIG SCHOOLS

- SIG money in the state of Utah is limited to \$2,300,000
 - These SIG grants are competitive in nature
 - Chances of getting two grants are low, more than that are really low
- Make application for South Kearns and West Lake Junior



GSD 2016 SIG MODEL

- Replace the principal
 - New principals begin mid-year
 - Allow principal to hit the ground running with a staff that has been vetted for their commitment to a shared vision
- Reconstitute the faculty and academic support staff
 - There is great power and efficiency in impacting school culture and beliefs with this model
- Name the principals early (goal to appoint in December) to involve them in all aspects of the plan
 - Creating the plans
 - Hiring the staff
 - Developing changes in PD, Collaboration and Instruction
- Add additional stipend to principal salary
- Begin hiring staff before all other schools
- Add additional stipend to teacher salary for additional PD
