Santa Sack Program Distributed 1,960 sacks
Value: \$50 per sack, **\$98,000**

56 Elementary Schools served. Only six (6) Elementary schools did not ask for assistance. Those schools not served were either in a more affluent part of the Granite community or had previous arrangements with large corporations and local businesses to provide assistance to all students enrolled at the school.

Preschool Services requested 122 Sacks
Hartvigsen requested 66 Sacks
Average distribution, 35 sacks per school
