The Purchasing Department has received a requisition requesting the purchase of architectural services for the CTE Manufacturing and Composite Materials Lab Project. This requisition has been signed by Mr. Jim Day and Mr. Don Adams.

A request for statements of qualifications (SOQ) was issued by the Purchasing Department seeking qualified architectural firms' proposals to perform the services. We received eight proposals in response to the SOQ. These proposals were scored against the published criteria in the SOQ by an evaluation committee. The following is the ranking of the proposals:

Dear Dr. Bates:

The Purchasing Department has received a requisition from the Educational Technology Department to order 7,000 HP brand Chromebook computers to distribute to schools for use in student testing and to help increase student learning. A guideline has been created to help school administrators implement the device into teacher curriculum.

January is the end of HP's fiscal quarter and they have offered a substantial discount if they can book the sale for their quarterly figures. In order to take advantage of this discounted price the purchase order had to be issued prior to January 31, 2016 through the state contract holder En Pointe Technologies, an authorized HP reseller. HP will discount the price of each Chromebook from \$187.52 to \$175.34, which represents a savings to the district of \$85,260.00.

After internal discussion and approval from Mr. David Garrett we issued a purchase order to En Pointe Technologies for \$1,227,380.00 to obtain the savings. Ratification of this action is respectfully requested. Funds for this expenditure are to come from Educational Technology funds.
