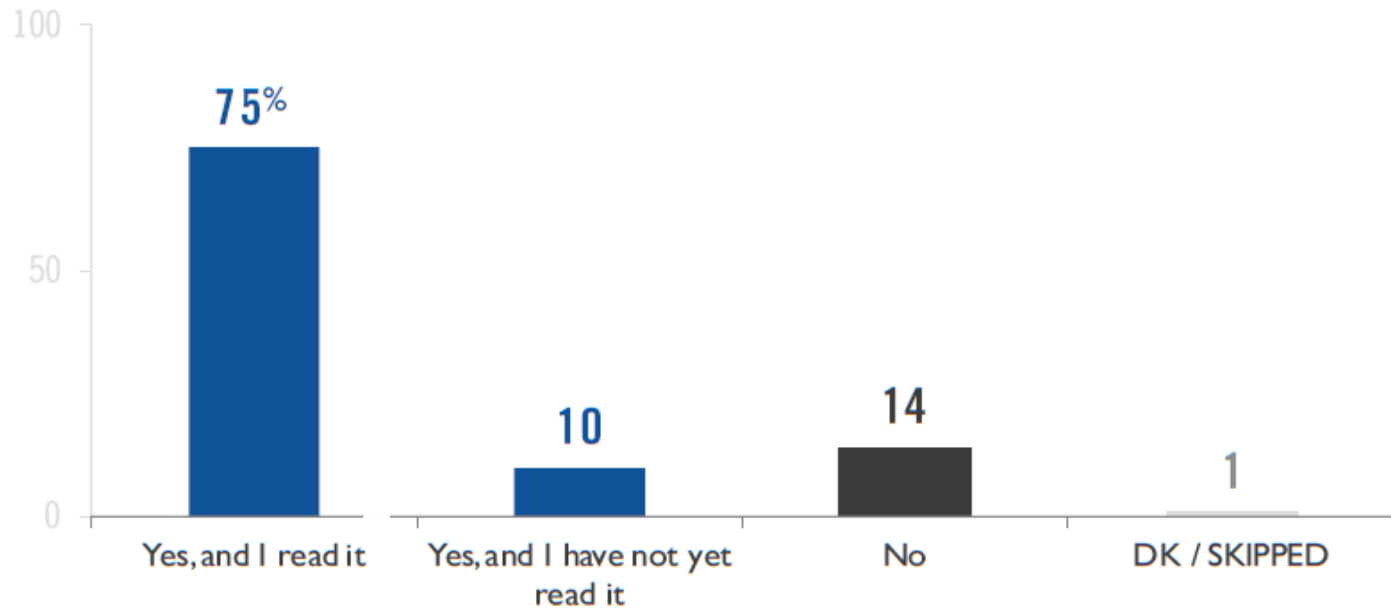

Did you receive an information packet about grade reconfiguration in the Skyline High School network of schools? Have you had a chance to read it?

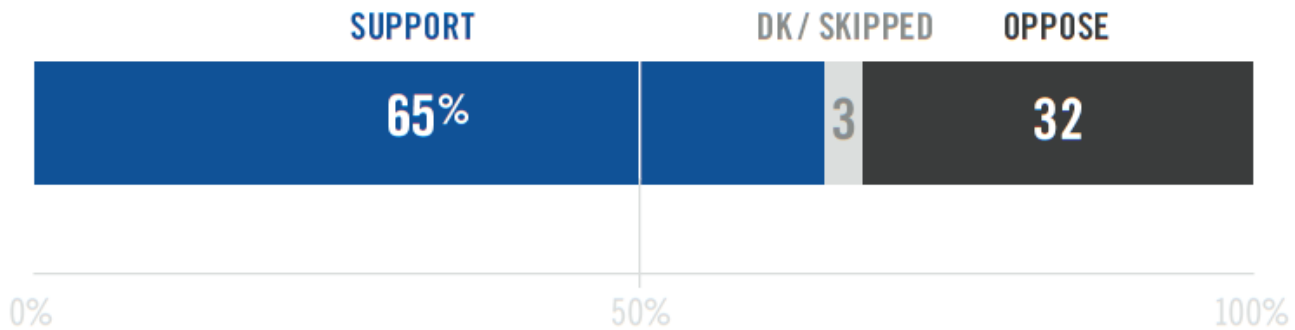


PARENT/GUARDIAN SUPPORT & OPPOSITION

A supermajority of parents and guardians support the proposal before the community councils.



Do you support or oppose the proposed grade reconfiguration – meaning that 6th grade students would attend school at Wasatch or Churchill Junior High Schools and 9th grade students would attend school with the rest of the high school students at Skyline High School?



SUPPORT BY IN /OUT OF NETWORK PARENTS

Parents who live in the Skyline boundaries are significantly MORE supportive than out-of-network parents.

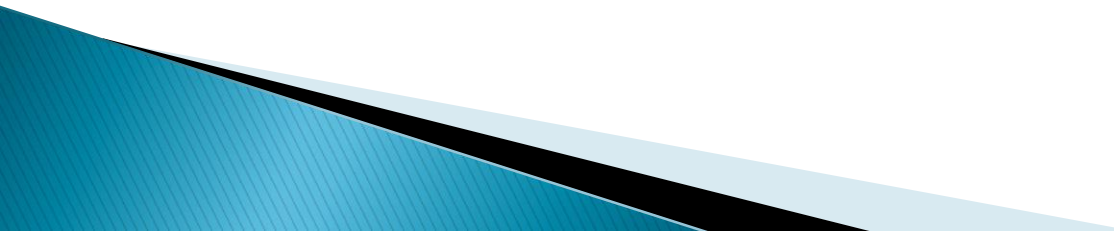
Results of Initial Council Votes

- ▶ **Skyline**
 - Unanimous in favor
- ▶ **Wasatch Jr.**
 - 9 in favor, 3 opposed
- ▶ **Churchill Jr.**
 - Unanimous in favor
- ▶ **Eastwood**
 - Unanimous in favor
- ▶ **Morningside**
 - 9 in favor, 1 opposed
- ▶ **Oakridge**
 - Unanimous in favor
- ▶ **Upland**
 - 9 opposed, 3 in favor

Results of Initial Council Votes

- ▶ Upland Terrace's Community Council no votes were "no, not now". The Council requested information on the following items for further discussion:
 - Special education special class placement
 - Projected population numbers
- ▶ Information was gathered, then presented and considered by the Upland Council throughout the summer.

Upland Re-Vote

- ▶ After considering the new information from the district departments, and additional input from the school community, the Upland Community Council moved to re-vote this morning.
 - ▶ The vote was 9 in favor, 1 against, and 1 abstention.

Skyline Reconfiguration Support

- ▶ All schools in Skyline Network are in agreement to move towards a 6–8, 9–12 grade reconfiguration.
