As a consent agenda item at the November 15, 2016, Board of Education meeting, I request that the Board approve amendments to the 2016-2017 School LAND Trust plan for the following schools:

- Cottonwood High
  - Allows funding for Chromebooks & carts.
  - Allows funding for professional development
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/12/2016.
- Cyprus High
  - Allows funding for Chromebooks & carts.
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 9/6/2016.
- Driggs Elementary
  - Allows funding for an additional aide.
  - Allows funding for additional technology equipment.
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 9/27/2016.
- Hunter High
  - Allows for an increase in technology from \$65,237 to \$87,035.
  - Allows funding for library books.
  - Allows for an increase in textbooks from \$1,000 to \$15,000
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/17/2016.
- Kearns High
  - Changed goal 1 to include Science.
  - Reduces salary to allow for science equipment and supplies
  - Reallocates \$20,000 for additional technology
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 9/10/2016.
- West Kearns Elementary
  - Reworded goals to align with their Title I plan.
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/7/2016.

- West Valley Elementary
  - Modified goal 1 to reflect 75% of students showing a 3% growth in reading
  - The average proficiency score for 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grades as measured by the Granite Math Benchmarks will increase from semester 1 pre-test to semester 1 post-test by 20%
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/4/2016.
- Wright Elementary
  - The \$26,000 in goal 2 for .5 FTE will be reallocated to purchase Chromebooks. The school's enrollment was up and therefor did not need to use LAND Trust for FTE.
  - Approved by the School Community Council on 9/27/2016.
