Dear Dr. Bates:

As part of the plan to reduce our Food Service Fund Balance to be within the required amount, we propose not charging students who qualify for reduced meals (the projected amount reduced will be approximately \$379,656 for the 2017-18 school year). We also propose keeping meal prices the same for breakfast in traditional breakfast programs and for lunch in all schools.

We propose this as a one-year trial program, requiring Board of Education approval next year and each subsequent year thereafter. Below is the recommended amounts for the 2017-2018 school year.

The last time the board approved a price change was for the 2012-2013 school year.
