The Board approved the original purchase order for the demolition of Granite High School in April 2017. A change order was necessary to include the extra salvage requests made by South Salt Lake City and Granite School District. Costs associated with requests from South Salt Lake will be reimbursed by the City. The greatest costs, over \$200,000 are associated with asbestos abatement from unknown materials. Additional asbestos was discovered as the contractor removed the different layers of the building.
