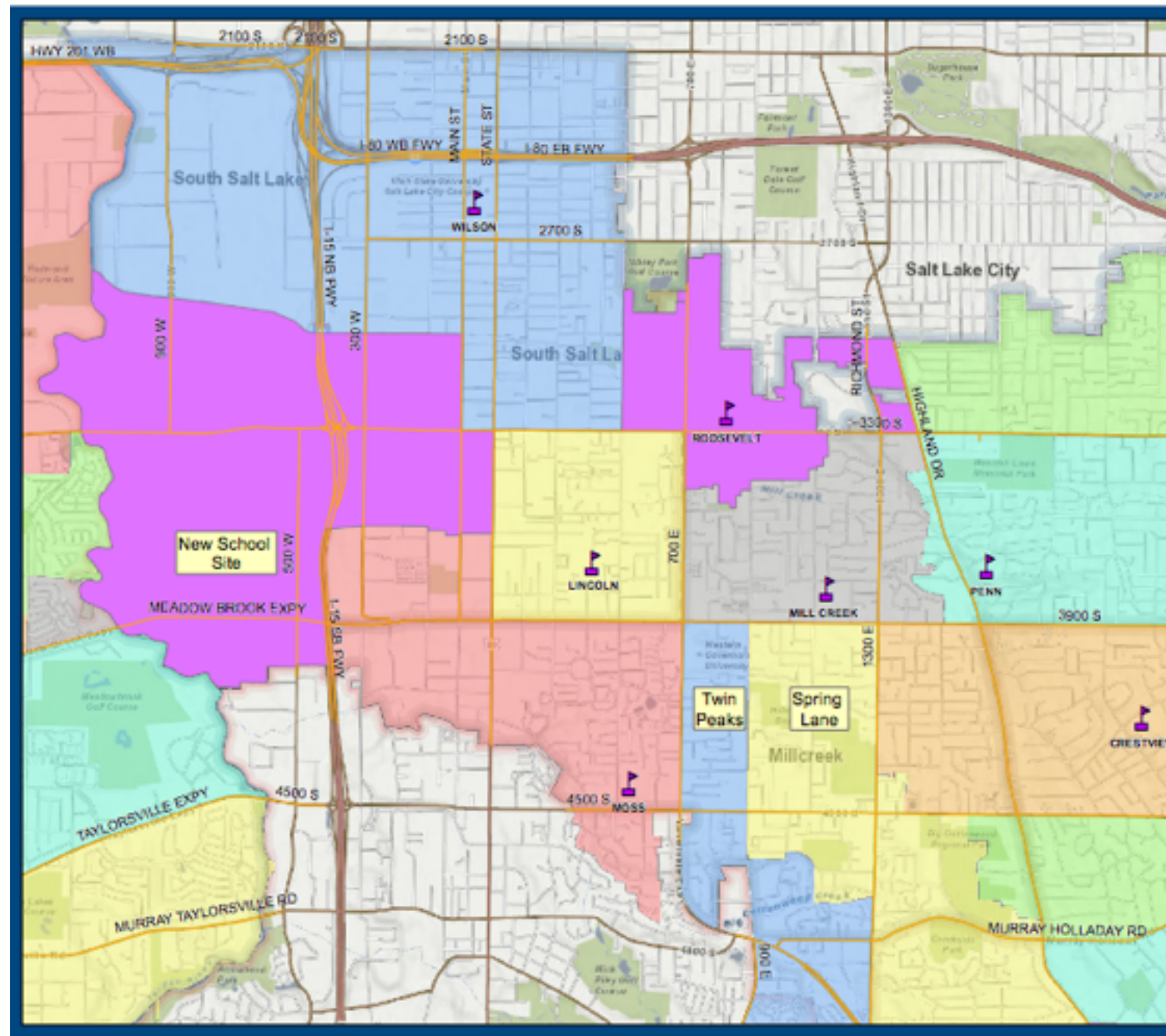


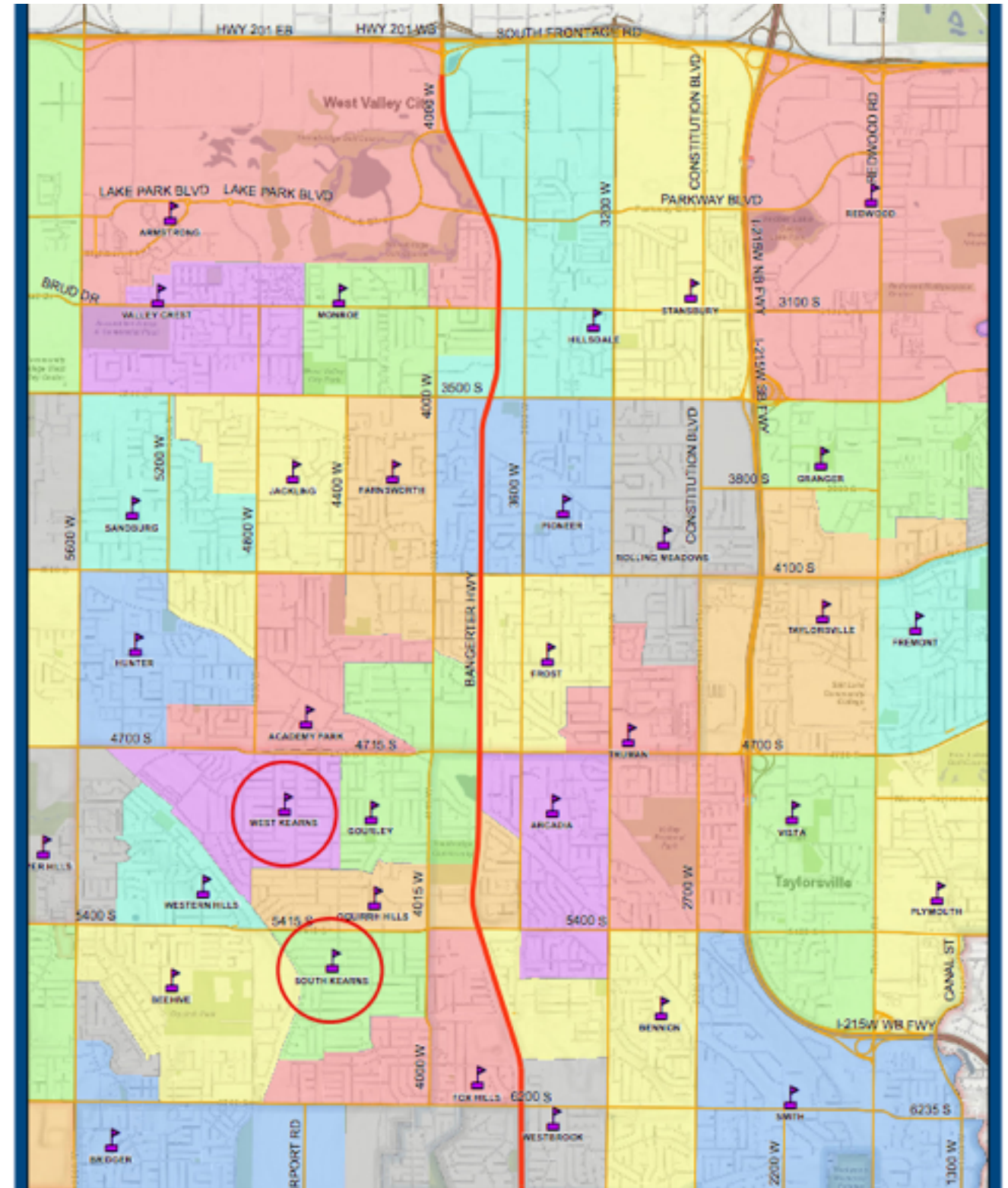
# Riverfront / Roosevelt (2-year Study)

- *Have held preliminary discussions with the PAC, district directors and principals and have begun building assessments, but no public meetings held to date*
- *Need to know results of Cottonwood Network Reconfiguration before holding public meetings because potential changes in enrollment will impact the direction of the study*



# Bangerter Corridor (2-year Study)

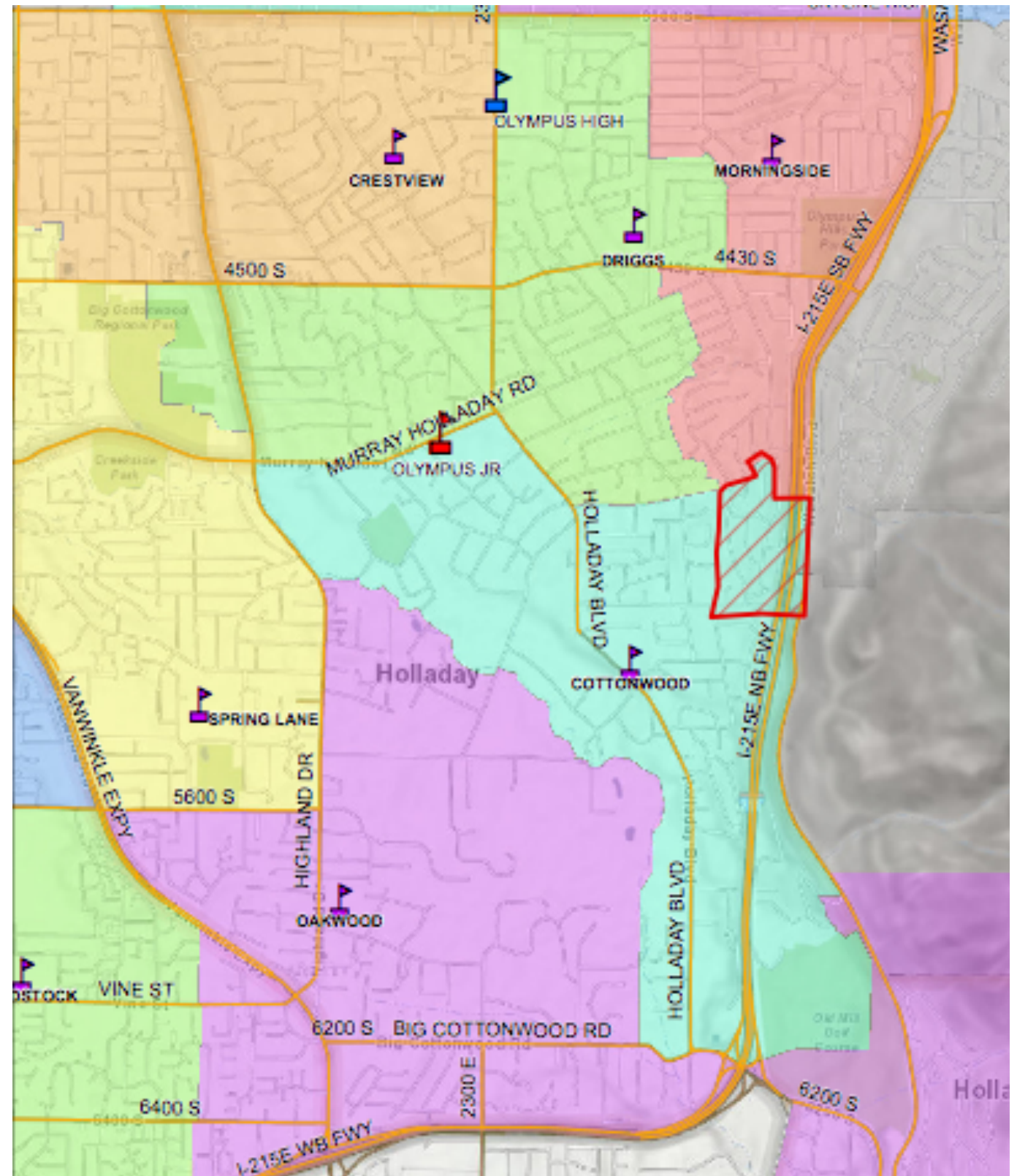
- Have held preliminary discussions with PAC, district directors and principals and have begun building assessments, but no public meetings held to date.
- Need to know results of Arcadia study and building design & construction timeline of South Kearns and West Kearns rebuild before beginning public meetings this fall





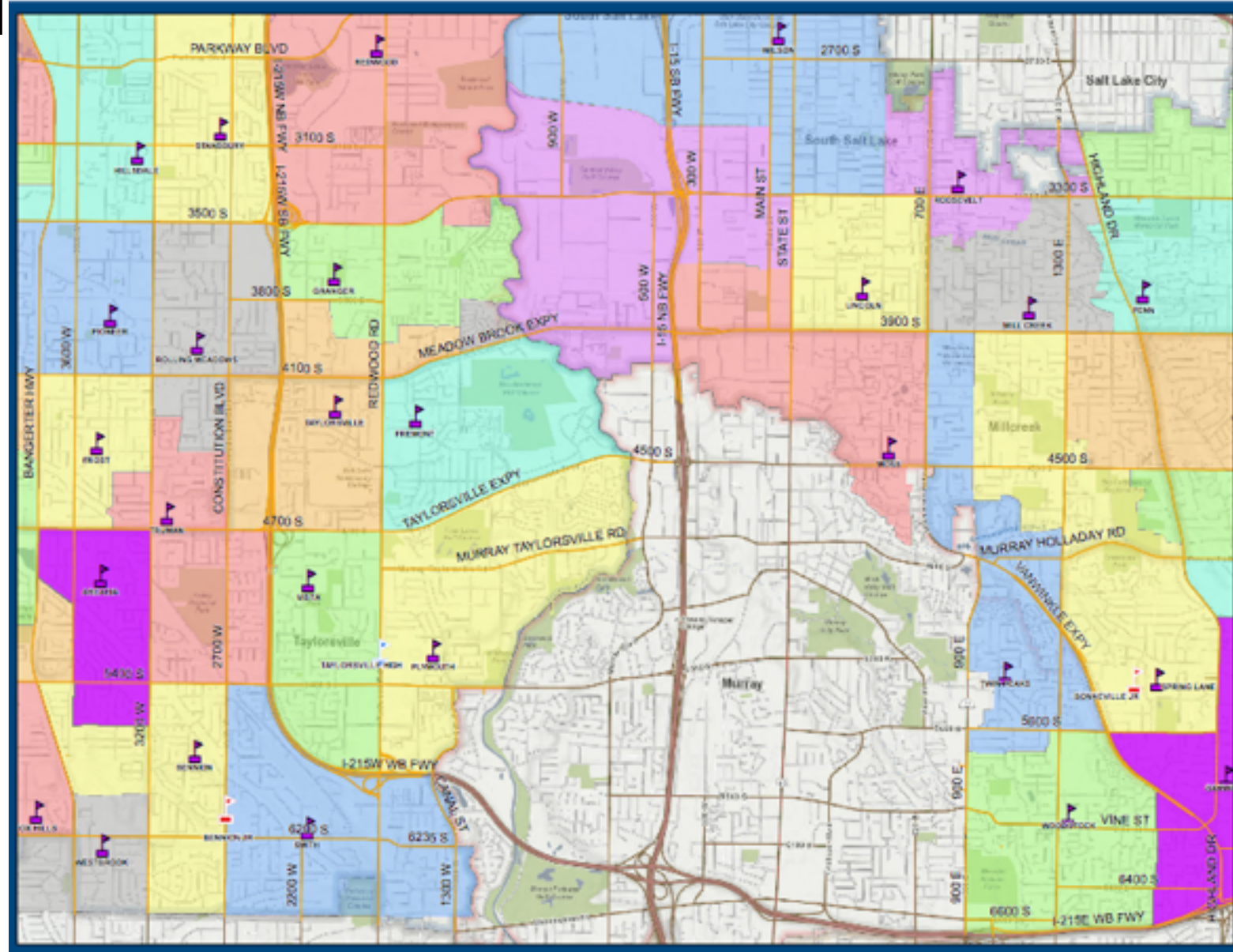
# Hawaiian Streets

- Involves approx. 25 students
- Cleans up a split feeder
- Negligible impact on enrollment at Olympus HS or Skyline HS
- No busing involved
- Held meeting with most of the patrons. They were unanimously in favor of the proposal. All emails have also been supportive of the change
- The PAC recommends approval of the proposed boundary change
- Would become effective fall 2019



# Arcadia Feeder Pattern

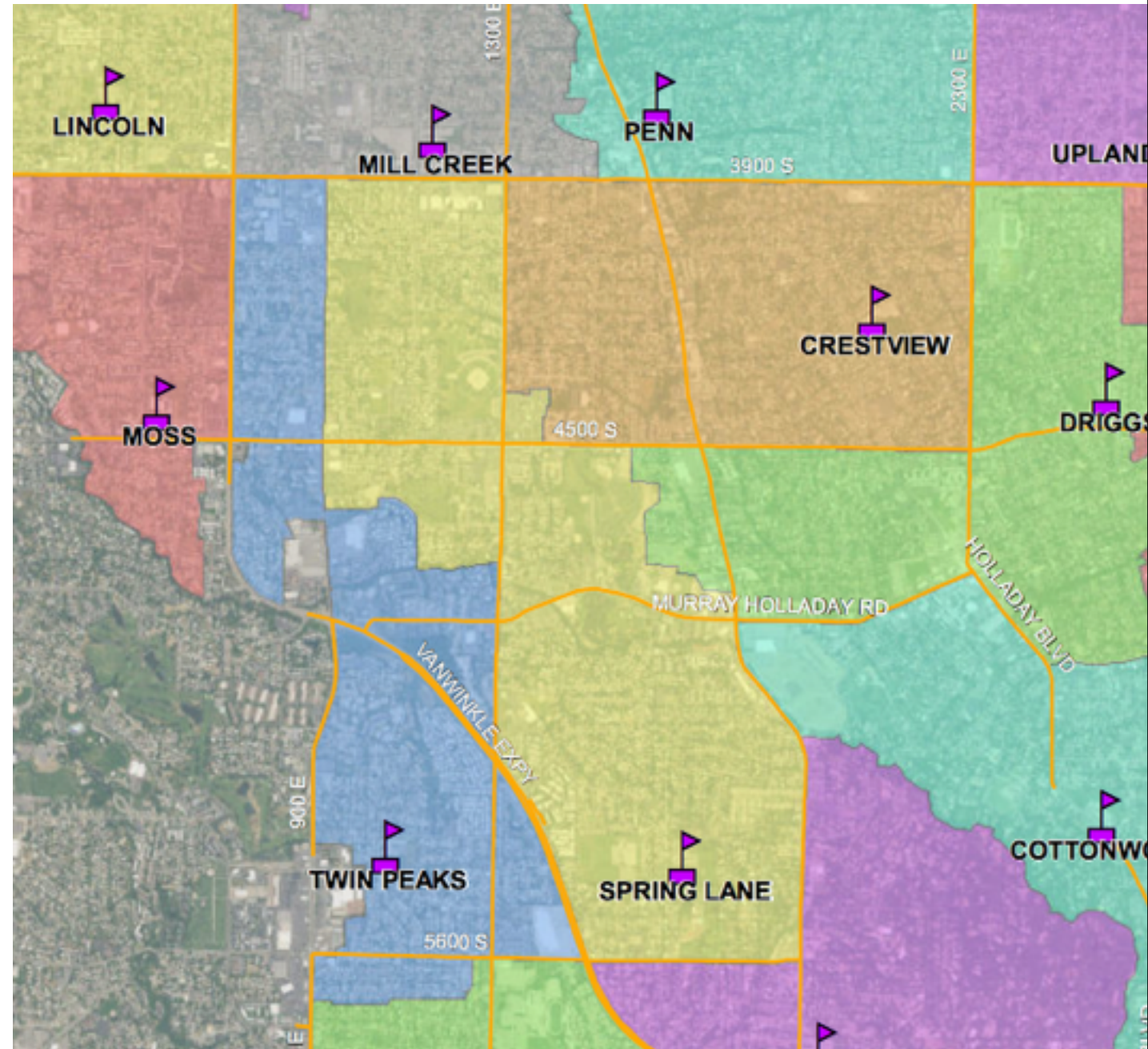
- Does Arcadia remain a feeder to Bonneville Jr and then Cottonwood HS or does it begin feeding into Bennion Jr and then Taylorsville HS ?
- Impacts? A net loss of 120-180 for Bonneville/Cottonwood and corresponding gain for Bennion/Taylorsville
- All SCC's have given approval
- Two community meetings held
- Survey Results? **80% in favor of change**
- Arcadia is requesting a decision





# Reconfiguration Boundary Study

- Soon after the Cottonwood reconfiguration study and Arcadia study began the Spring Lane & Twin Peaks feeder changes began to emerge as a logical extension of both
- Both schools are currently split feeders, with 30% of Spring Lane and 15% of Twin Peaks feeding into Evergreen Jr and Olympus High
- This proposal would create a clean feeder to Bonneville Jr and Cottonwood High.





# Reconfiguration Boundary Study

-continued-

- This would add apprx. 60 students to Bonneville Jr and 100 to Cottonwood High
- Grandfathering: Students that have begun at Evergreen Jr or Olympus HS would be allowed to remain, with 2 years of busing provided
- Busing to Bonneville Jr and Cottonwood HS? Yes, busing *would continue* for all students to Bonneville Jr and Cottonwood HS
- **If change is not made, and reconfiguration is approved, it leaves Spring Lane with a 6th grade of 16 students and Twin Peaks with a 6th grade of 8 students**
