

Hawaiian Streets

- Involves approx. 25 students
- Cleans up a split feeder
- Negligible impact on enrollment at Olympus HS or Skyline HS
- No busing involved
- Held meeting with most of the patrons. They were unanimously in favor of the proposal. All emails have also been supportive of the change
- The PAC recommends approval of the proposed boundary change
- Would become effective fall 2019



Twin Peaks/Spring Lane Feeder Pattern Study

- Soon after the Cottonwood reconfiguration study and Arcadia study began the Spring Lane & Twin Peaks feeder changes began to emerge as a logical extension of both
- Both schools are currently split feeders, with 30% of Spring Lane and 15% of Twin Peaks feeding into Evergreen Jr and Olympus High
- This proposal would create a clean feeder to Bonneville Jr and Cottonwood High.



Twin Peaks/Spring Lane Feeder Pattern Study

- This would add apprx. 60 students to Bonneville Jr and 100 to Cottonwood High
- Grandfathering: Students that have begun at Evergreen Jr or Olympus HS would be allowed to remain, with 2 years of busing provided
- Busing to Bonneville Jr and Cottonwood HS? Yes, busing would continue for all students to Bonneville Jr and Cottonwood HS
- Since reconfiguration has been approved for the Bonneville Jr portion of the network, Spring Lane would have a 6th grade of 16 students and Twin Peaks a 6th grade of 8 students
