At the May 7, 2019 Board of Education meeting the Board approved contracting with the non-profit organization Equal Opportunity Schools with the intent of closing the race and income participation gaps in AP/IB courses, raise test score performance as measured by exam passing, and develop systems and structures for the district to sustain and improve upon these results in future years at Cottonwood, Cyprus, Granger, and Hunter High Schools. The value of this agreement was \$97,600.00.

After the approval was received a new request was received to add Kearns and Hunter High Schools to the contract.
