Dear Dr. Bates,

As part of the owner requested change to add the temporary student parking lot on the southwest corner of the existing site, we felt compelled to add additional parking for students for the duration of the project. The work and scope of this change resulted in a change order of \$208,891.99 to Herm Hughes Construction.

The change order costs include:

1. Removing the existing sod.
2. Grading the contour to allow for driving and parking.
3. Import road base and compaction as required.
4. Install asphalt paving and striping.

This change order will meet the needs of the school and surrounding community by providing a safe place for students to park for the duration of the rebuild.
