

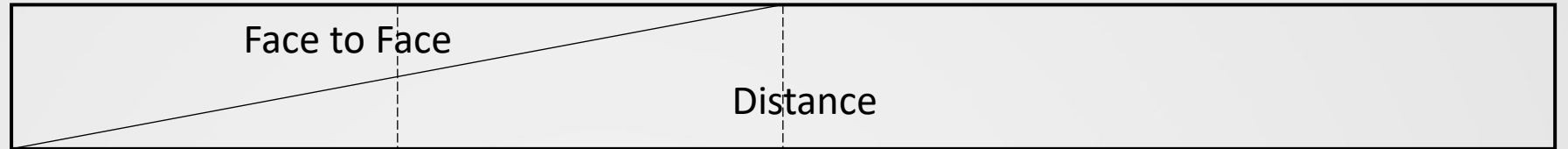

 - Distance learning for all

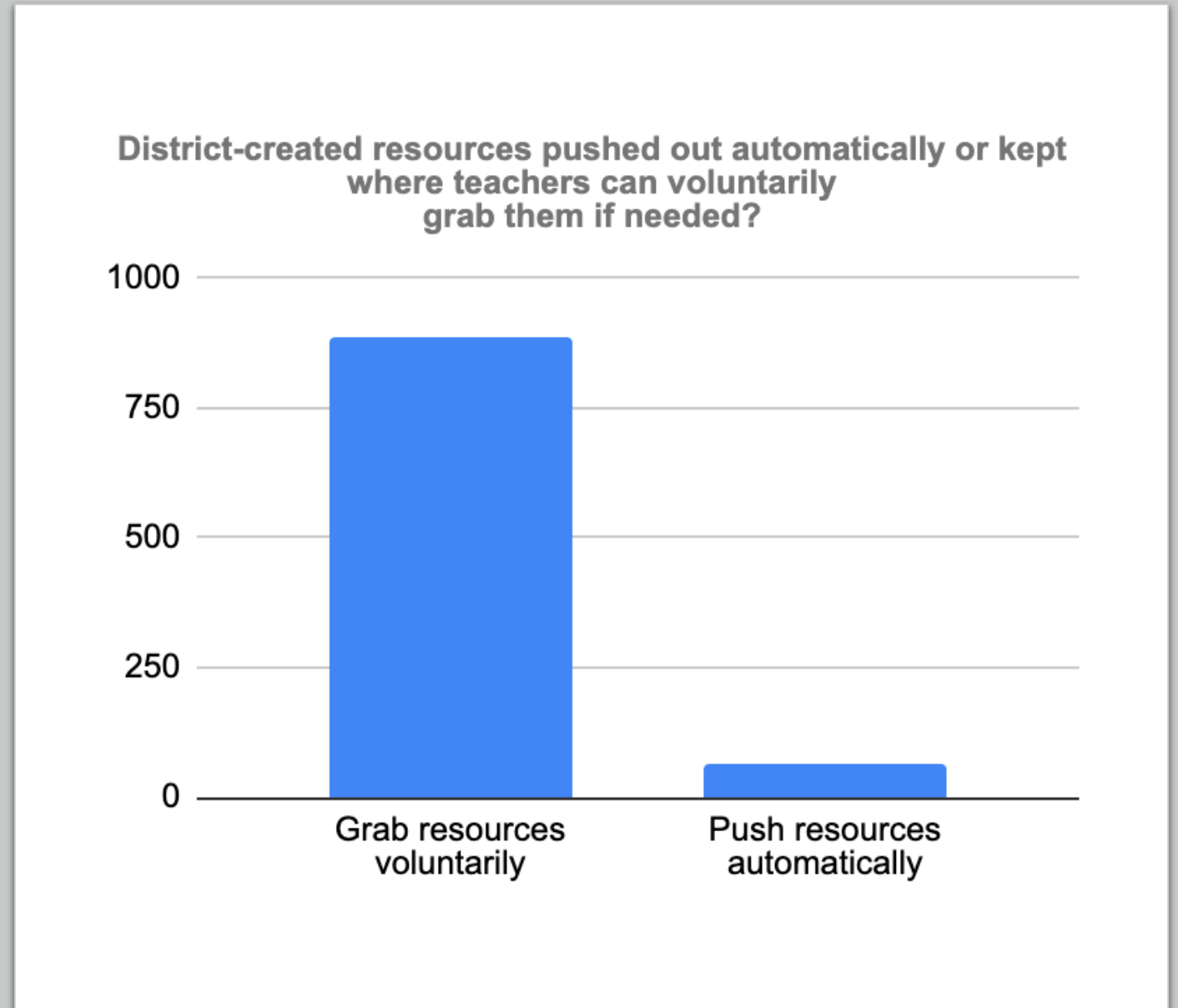
Distance Learning Teacher Feedback Survey

- Over 1000 teacher responses – 61% Elementary 59% Secondary

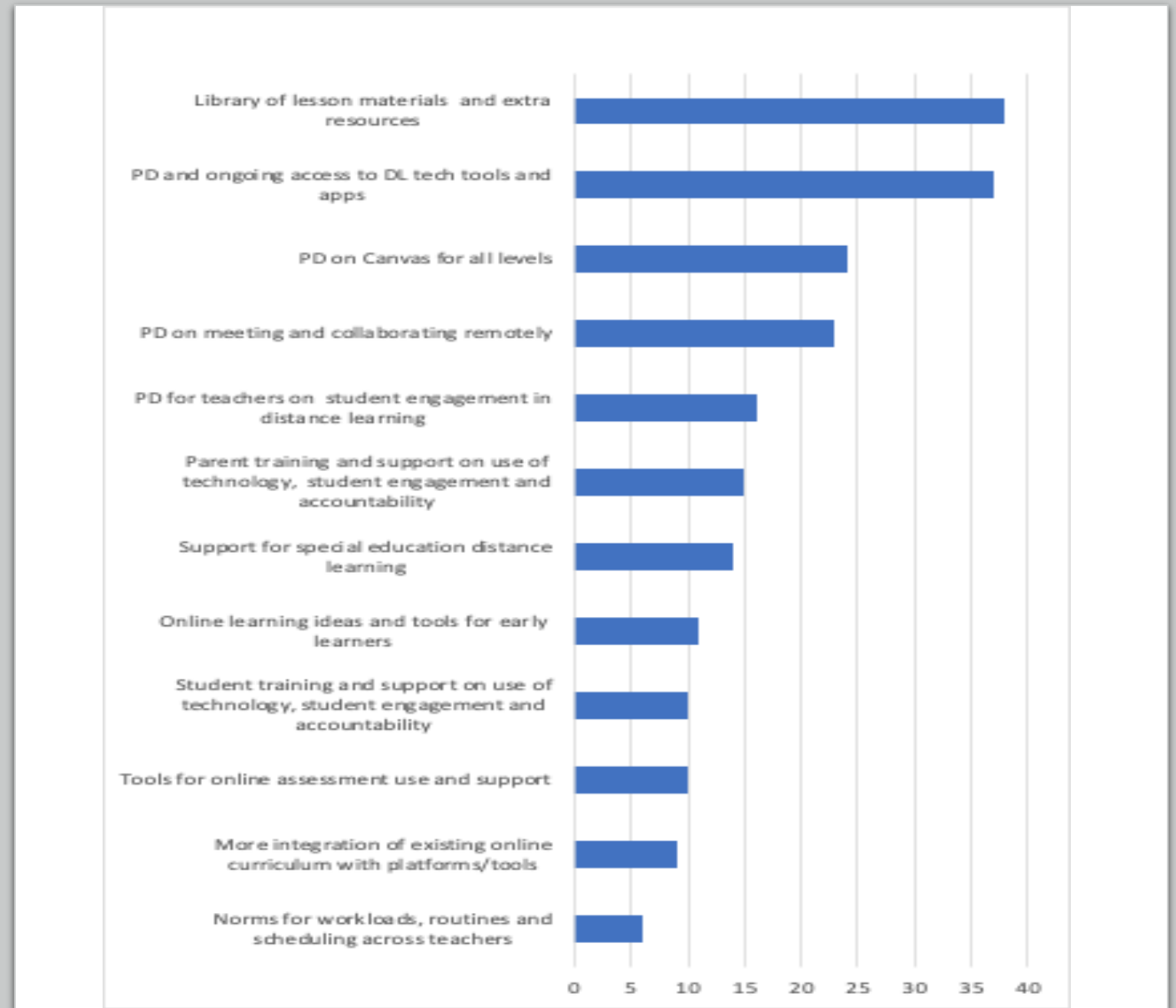
Teacher Ranked Areas of Need – Top 3

Plan for Distance Learning Support

- Distance Learning Coursework Library and Examples K-12
 - Developed by district office specialists and school level teacher teams
 - Scope and sequence aligned learning activities
 - Tools, lessons, tasks, and assessments
 - Core curriculum resources and materials

Plan for Distance Learning Support

- Administrator learning event during admin kick-off day
- Professional learning event time prior to student attendance
- Instructional preparation time prior to student attendance
- Professional learning coaching
 - School Technology Specialist 1:2 elementary school ratio
 - Library Media Technology Specialist 1:1 secondary school ratio
 - District Specialists
