The Purchasing Department has received a requisition requesting the purchase of nine months rental of the Kearns Oquirrh Park Fitness Center pools for the school year 2020-21. This requisition has been signed by Mr. Kieth Bradshaw and Mr. David Garrett.

The district has been renting these facilities since 1990 through a memorandum of understanding ("MOU"). Dear Dr. Bates:

The Purchasing Department has received a sole source request from the Accounting Department seeking a contract for virtual vendor payment processing services. These services will allow the Accounting Department to issue electronic payments to many of our regularly paid vendors, allowing for a reduction in the number of checks being issued by the district and some of the soft costs associated with that processing. Additionally, the district will receive a rebate from bank interchange processing fees.

Fidelity Information Services ("FIS") is the sole source vendor to provide these services because they have an exclusive partnership agreement with our financial systems software provider, Harris Software. Notice of the district's intent to contract with FIS was posted publicly as required by state law. No comments were received to oppose the contract.

Permission is requested to enter a contract with Fidelity Information Services for a 5-year term. The estimated fees that FIS will collect for their services over the term of the contract is \$200,000.00. Their fees will also come from the bank interchange fees, so the district will only directly pay approximately \$200 per month in direct charges. Rebates to the district under the agreement are estimated to be \$725,000.00 during the term of the contract resulting in a revenue generating contract.
