As a consent agenda item at the October 6, 2020 Board of Education meeting, I request the Board approve the following amendments to the 2020-2021 School LAND Trust plan:

- Gearld Wright Elementary
 - Allows funding for technology.
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 8/26/2020.
- Neil Armstrong Academy – to utilize the carryover from 2019-2020, the following have been added:
 - Funding for Paraeducators.
 - Increase library books from \$1,000 to \$5,000.
 - Funding to facilitate science instruction in the greenhouse.
 - Fundig for eTextbooks/online curriculum.
 - Funding for Chromebooks
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 9/1/2020.
- Olympus Jr. High
 - Allows funding for ALEKS licenses instead of Shmoop.
 - Allows funding for two SmartBoards.
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 9/10/2020.
- Rosecrest Elementary
 - Allows funding for math manipulatives.
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 7/24/2020.
- Twin Peaks Elementary
 - Allows all funding for Paraeducators.
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 8/27/2020.
- Upland Terrace Elementary
 - Reallocates funds from substitutes and Hands-on Science to Paraeducators.
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 9/3/2020.
