As required by state law public notice of the intent to award a contract without engaging in a standard procurement process was posted as notice JF21-012 SS and received no comments or objections.


A negotiated written renewal quote has been obtained from Karen Lass, Sales Representative, Education Solutions Development.

The Purchasing Department received a request to purchase mobile hotspots to provide for student home internet service. The devices will be managed by the Educational Technology Department and will be checked-out to students who lack access to the internet in their home. These additional hotspots will augment our current fleet of 1,000 devices that were approved by the Board at their May 5, 2020 meeting.

The purchase contains 1,250 devices and internet services for one calendar year. This program is available to the district purchase under state of Utah contract MA-176.

We respectfully request approval to contract with T-Mobile for these hotspots and to release a pay voucher for the expenses totaling \$300,000.00. Funds for this expenditure are to come from the K-12 Broadband Grant from the Utah State Board of Education.
