As a consent agenda item at the December 1, 2020 Board of Education meeting, I request the Board approve the following amendments to the 2020-2021 School LAND Trust plan:

- Cyprus High School
 - Moves funding for software to teacher stipends so teachers can provide more interventions for struggling students.
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 1/10/2020.
- Matheson Jr. High
 - Moves funding from professional and technical Services, transportation, and printing to teacher salaries for the cost of extra periods to lower class sizes.
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 10/26/2020.
- Valley Jr. High
 - Moves funding for a social worker to .0275 FTE towards a math teacher, extra periods, additional technology, and teacher stipends.
 - Approved by the School Community Council on 11/18/2020.
