Dear Dr. Bates,

As part of our need to relocate West Lake Junior High School to the Westbrook campus, procurement of an additional relocatable structure is required to provide a FACS lab to meet curriculum requirements for students. The relocatable was not required last year because the curriculum only requires the FACS cooking component in one of the two years students take the course.

Due to this requirement and given the hectic nature of the initial relocation of West Lake, this relocatable was postponed. That being said, the summer timeframe for installation of the relocatable is quickly approaching. A formal bid was not received until after the previous Board deadline creating the need for ratification. A purchase order was issued to US Modular for \$348,120. The relocatable structure is eligible for insurance reimbursement and said costs will be paid to the district in the coming weeks. It was imperative that the custom relocatable facility be purchased in time for the manufacturer to include it into their production schedule to ensure installation in time for the 2021-2022 school year. We respectfully request ratification of this action.
