

THE ROAD TO GRADE RECONFIGURATION

Granite School District is formally proposing K-5, 6-8, 9-12 grade reconfiguration for the Cyprus, Granger and Hunter networks to become effective when major construction projects are completed in 2025. The district and the Board of Education have been gathering data on grade reconfiguration for several years, and this proposal is intended to bring about the best outcomes for students.

An informational meeting is held to review the public input process.



2

District representatives meet with school community councils in a network and put together an informational packet on reconfiguration.



3

The district conducts a survey to gather community feedback. School communities then gather to discuss survey results and other pertinent information.



4

Reconfiguration information is presented during a Board of Education meeting. A formal recommendation from district administration is presented to the board.



5

If approved by the board, schools, with support from the district, make preparations for grade reconfiguration to be implemented.
