Looking Back at 2020-2021

- ◆ Total funding available to schools: \$7,853,947.00
- ◆ Final Reports have been completed by school principals.

Some Reminders:

- ◆ Appropriate academic areas include anything that is a core standard.
- ◆ Priorities in ELA, Math, Science, and (for high schools) College & Career Readiness and graduation rate increase must be addressed first (but not necessarily by LAND Trust funds); then, councils may consider other priorities, such as Financial Literacy, Fine Arts, Health, Ed Tech, Physical Education, Social Studies, and World Languages.
- ◆ There is no expenditure limit on behavioral components for academic goals, but goals are academic in nature and must be measured by student academic success (including a baseline); standalone behavioral goals are not allowed.
- ◆ New council advisory roles provide the school principal input in preparing a Positive Behaviors Plan that address the student use of tobacco, alcohol, electronic cigarettes, etc.

Other Information:

- ◆ USBE updated the LAND Trust website on which school principals enter information, including upcoming school plans.
- ◆ As part of this website update, district programs no longer have their own LAND Trust account, requiring:
 - ◆ Jones Center plans and budgets to be subsumed under Hartvigsen.
 - ◆ Safe School plans and budgets to be subsumed under YESS.
- ◆ School LAND Trust allocations based on Per Pupil Allocation; the range of allocations is directly proportional to October 1, enrollments. For example:
 - ◆ Granger High School's 2021-2022 LAND Trust allocation is \$422,433.82
 - ◆ Twin Peaks Elementary School's 2021-2022 LAND Trust allocation is \$34,442.43.

Looking ahead to 2022-2023

- ◆ Total funding available to schools: \$7,915,902.00.
- ◆ School Community Councils have met to identify areas of critical academic need, set academic goals, and have planned 2022-2023 LAND Trust spending.
- ◆ School principals have input these plans and proposed expenditures on school LAND Trust sites.
- ◆ These plans have been approved by the Organizational Effectiveness Department and now await Board approval.

Some Reminders

- ◆ Guidelines found in GSD's [School Community Council Handbook](#).
- ◆ Non-allowable LAND Trust expenditures include: accreditation, facility costs, and expenses that are non-academic, co-curricular, or extra-curricular in nature.
- ◆ Allowable expenditures are those that improve student achievement in critical academic needs. Examples include: credit recovery, study skills courses, college entrance exam preparation classes, academic field trips, classroom supplies and materials, teachers and teacher aides, professional development tied directly to school's academic goals, student-focused educational technology.

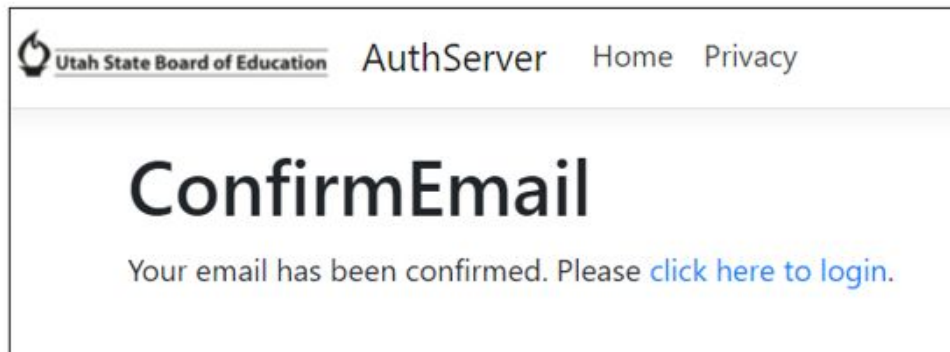



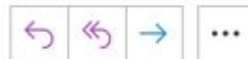
