Dear Dr. Nye,

Over the past three months we have been reporting on the progress of structural repairs to concrete piers located in the crawlspace at Fremont Elementary School. Repairs have been going well but our structural engineer identified additional areas where decay has compromised the interior structural shear walls. These walls were not identified as the contract documents were being prepared and only found after more in-depth investigation occurred. The contractor was asked to provide a cost to perform this additional repair work.

The repair is necessary in maintaining structural integrity of the original classroom portion of this school. It is recommended this work be performed at this time as it supports the most cost-effective approach. The additional repairs result in a construction cost increase to Wasatch West Contracting in the amount of \$53,300.50. This includes all material and labor.
