

Article VIII.A.31. Tutoring Students for Remuneration

A. Statement of Policy

Teachers employed by the Board should abide by the following guidelines:

1. Students who seek private tutoring should be encouraged to study with competent instructors other than teachers who teach them in the schools. If teachers tutor their own students, the solicitation must be initiated by the parents and approved by the principal. Teachers shall use facilities outside the school for such instruction. Teachers shall give such instruction outside regular school hours.
2. It could happen that a student might be receiving private tutoring from the same teacher who has the responsibility of casting students in parts of a drama, speech event, musical program or other performance at school. In this eventuality, such selection shall be made with the cooperation of the school principal and the teacher/tutor.
